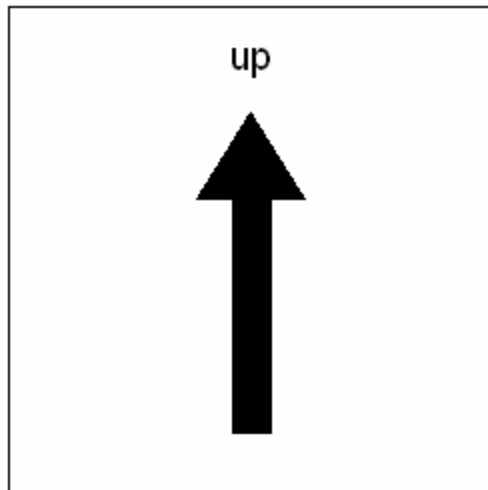
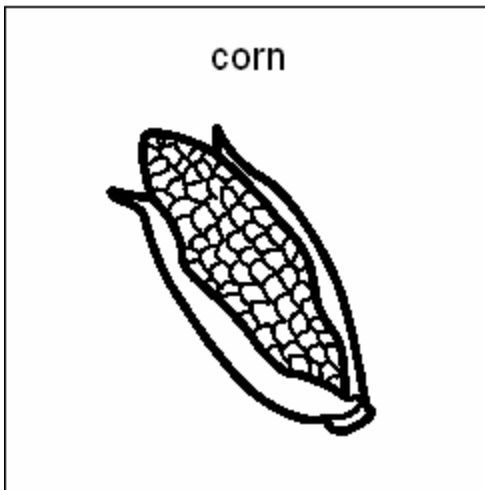
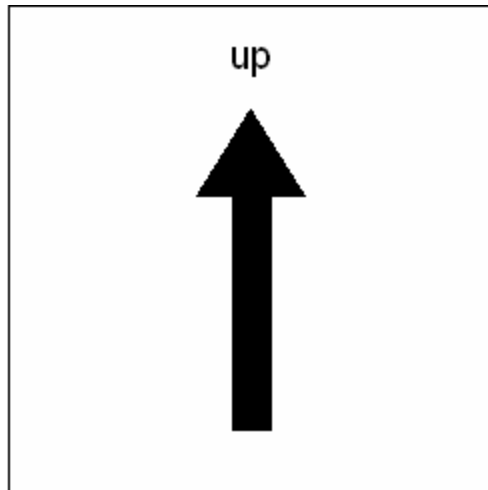
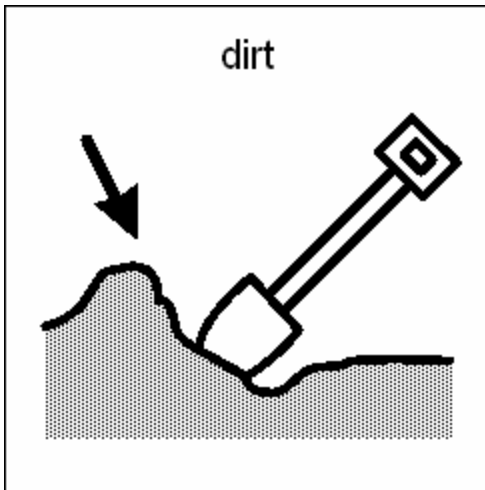


Adapting Up, Down and Around

All books typically used with preschoolers can be made accessible for children with special needs. Boardmaker is a drawing program with a clipart library containing 3300+ Picture Communication Symbols (PCS). Permission has been granted by Boardmaker to use these symbols with the **PA One Book: Every Young Child** title *Up, Down, and Around* by Katherine Ayers.

Make copies of the pages of symbols. Laminate the pages before cutting out each square for longer use. Small pieces of Velcro may be adhered to each page in the book. Read the book aloud to children with special needs. Encouraged the child to stick the correct symbol on the page in the book where it is the most appropriate.



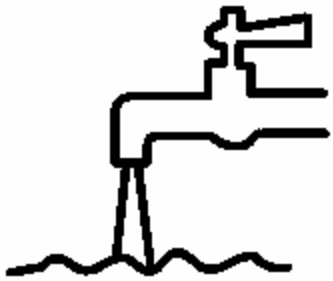
